


Agricultural Bamboo 2 Days Imersive Workshop

"The climate is changing, the agriculture must adapt."



Bamboo cultivation in Southern
Europe, under certain conditions,
has a very promising future.

Two days of theoretical and, above all, practical training in the field will enable you to make an informed decision, free from intrusive and misleading marketing.

Together, we can study your specific case, and based on the information you provide, we will create a tailored simulation to achieve optimal productivity (€10,000 to €80,000 per hectare per year once production begins, with no need for annual replanting).

The training is led by:

Yves Crouzet, an agronomist specializing in bamboo cultivation and honorary president of the European Bamboo Association. He managed and developed the Bambouseraie de Anduze park (in Cévennes) for nearly 30 years and, in 1990, founded the Portuguese company Bambuparque, which specializes in bamboo cultivation and production.

Akash Thapaliya, director of Bambuparque, also a bamboo specialist, originally from Nepal, a country with many bamboo species.

The lessons are given in: French, English and Portuguese.







Main topics covered:

Selecting species according to local conditions and production goals.

Land preparation, planting, irrigation, and maintenance according to seasons and production objectives. Product harvesting.

How to add value to your products, how and where to sell them.

A visit to our plantations and artisanal facilities for producing high-value products from locally grown bamboo.

A forward-looking perspective on the development of the bamboo market in Europe. What to do and what to avoid to succeed.

The workshop takes place in Portugal, at Bambuparque, a 114-hectare estate dedicated to bamboo cultivation and production (with 260 different species, about 100 of which are listed in the catalog).

It is located 200 km south of Lisbon and 8 km from the ocean, between the towns of Odemira and São Teotónio.









This two-days immersive workshop is limited to 12 participants per session and will be offered in 2025 on the following dates:

April 5th - 6th April 15th - 16th August 4th - 5 th August 9th - 10 th

The cost of the classes is €200.
